FIRE AT KUALITI ALAM WASTE MANAGEMENT CENTRE AIR QUALITY AT A SAFE LEVEL

SEREMBAN, 1 March 2015 — The air quality surrounding the neighbourhood areas of Kualiti Alam Waste Management Centre is at a safe level, following the fire at the facility on 27 February 2015.

The Department of Environment (DOE) has confirmed the air quality level based on air quality monitoring carried out by DOE, Alam Sekitar Malaysia (ASMA) and Kualiti Alam since 28 February 2015. There were seven (7) air quality monitoring stations has been set up to continuously monitor the air quality in Bandar Sri Sendayan and Seremban 2.

Kualiti Alam is working consistently with all relevant authorities to investigate the cause of the incident in details and any precautionary measures related to the incident.

The Kualiti Alam Waste Management Centre will resume its business operations on 2 March 2015.
