**FIRE AT KUALITI ALAM WASTE MANAGEMENT CENTRE UNDER CONTROL  
No injuries and fatalities recorded**

**SEREMBAN, October 2, 2019** – The fire which broke out at Kualiti Alam Sdn Bhd at 1.06 pm today has been brought under control with all 258 staff accounted for and no injuries or casualties reported.

The fire which started at the transit storage area did not cause any major damage to the facility, and was brought under control by 3.45 pm.

Upon discovery of the fire, Emergency response procedures were immediately put into effect by the Kualiti Alam Emergency Response Team while the Fire and Rescue Department attended to the site. All employees and contractors were safely evacuated.

The cause of the fire has yet to be determined and we are currently working closely with the Negeri Sembilan Fire and Rescue Department, Department of Environment (DoE), Department of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH) and the Police (PDRM) to determine the cause. A full investigation is already under way.

We are also working with the authorities to undertake a detailed inspection to ensure the safety of the facility before we recommence operations, as well as to safeguard the wellbeing of surrounding communities. Our Health, Safety, Security and Environment (HSSE) team is continuously monitoring the air quality, and from our gas readings at the site, there has been no detection of dangerous gases released.

The Fire and Rescue Department will announce the cause of the incident and any precautionary measures related to the incident in due course.
