



KUALITI ALAM EXPECTS TO TREAT 300 KG MEDICAL WASTES PER HOUR

Kualiti Alam Expects To Treat 300 Kg Medical Wastes Per Hour

SEREMBAN, Nov 24 (Bernama) -- Kualiti Alam Sdn Bhd, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Cenviro Sdn Bhd, expects its newly launched Clinical Waste Treatment Centre (CWTC) to process up to 300 kg of medical wastes per hour.

Cenviro Chief Executive Officer Khalid Bahsoon said the centre's microwave ecosteryl system uses minimal electricity while providing a safe and environmentally-friendly solution to bio-medical and clinical-related industry players.

"It is a zero-emissions technology, no harmful effects, no water, no steam, no odour, no burning or smoke.

"The residue from the process is inert and landfill-ready," he told reporters at the launch of CWTC in Sendayan near here today by Princess Astrid of Belgium.

Also in attendance were Cenviro Chairman Datuk Seri Ismail Shahudin, Federal Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs and European Affairs Didier Reynders, Federal Secretary of State for Foreign Trade Pieter De Crem and Ambassador of Belgium to Malaysia Daniel Dargent.

Kualiti Alam's other facilities -- incineration plant, physical-chemical treatment plant, solidification and secured landfill -- can store, treat and dispose of more than 100,000 tonnes of all classes of hazardous waste annually.
