The local community from five (5) villages surrounding the facility namely Kg Sendayan, Kg Jimah Baru, Kg Jimah Lama, Kg Gadong Jaya and Ladang Tanah Merah have been called for a briefing with Cenviro Group's Board of Directors held in the facility yesterday.
